# Uniform

## PRIMARY SCHOOL

- Royal Blue sport shirt & black sport shorts
- Navy Blue Soft Shell Jacket and navy pants
- Cap with logo (for sport)
- Black, white or navy “tekkies”
- No leggings / jeggings / tights or ripped jeans

**HIGH SCHOOL** - We continue wearing civvies as indicated below:

Modesty is required at all times – UNIFORMITY of colours, black / blue / grey / white.

- no see through clothing
- no derogatory or offensive slogans or branding and no messages contrary to Biblical principles
- no short skirts for girls (four fingers above the knee)
- no mid-drift tops or spaghetti tops for girls
- No leggings / jeggings / tights or ripped jeans

## Hair & Nails

- ✓ Clean & short nails - must not show over finger tips (safety for sport activities & during break times)
- ✓ No colour cutex (only clear)
- ✓ **PRIMARY SCHOOL** : Boys Hair - short and neat / Girls Hair - long hair tied back and out of the face, hair accessories must be navy, royal blue or black (same as school uniform).
- ✓ **HIGH SCHOOL** : Hair for both boys and girls must be out of the face & eyes - long hair must be tied back neatly.
- ✓ No unnatural coloring of hair, i.e. Blue green, pink, etc.
- ✓ Boys faces must be clean shaven.

## Make-Up & Jewelry

- ✓ No base or foundation, eye-shadow, eye-liner, mascara, lipstick, lip gloss, colour lip ice is permitted.
- ✓ **PRIMARY SCHOOL** - No jewelry is permitted, except for safe, small earrings for girls pierced ears.
- ✓ **HIGH SCHOOL** - No earrings for boys / girls must have safe, small earrings, not more than two piercings per ear. Neck chains, bracelets and rings may be worn as long as it does NOT have derogatory or anti-Christian signs or slogans.
- ✓ **NO JEWELRY** for any grade for sport practices or matches.

Before learners leave for school in the morning parents must see to it that they are appropriately dressed, properly washed (including brushing of teeth) and deodorant applied to avoid body odors.

# *Transport*

*The school has no transport of its own, therefore we rely on parents' co-operation for transport to any school event which might occur.*

*We request parents, whenever possible, to be available to transport students to sport events and school outings.*

## *Discipline and Detention*

*Discipline is seen as a preventative action rather than a form of punishment. It must be seen as what is done for the child and not what is done to him/her.*

*When detention slips are handed out, parents will be required to sign the notice and return it to school the following day.*
