Parent & Educator Contact / Interviews

The parents and educators work together as a team in the education of their children. It is of utmost importance that the parents & educators communicate on a regular basis regarding the progress of the child.

There are two scheduled compulsory Parent Interviews during the year. These interviews are during the first and third term. Parents are expected to attend these interviews as arranged by the educator.

During the second and fourth term there are scheduled voluntary interviews. Parents are free to make an appointment accordingly.

If a parent wishes to see the educator (or vice versa) regarding the child's progress, at other than these scheduled times, an appointment should be arranged as soon as possible.

Quarterly Parent Meetings & AGM's

It is vital for all parents to attend these meetings, as significant issues are discussed and important decisions are made which affect the running of the entire school.

Please note:

*No phone calls or parent interviews will be allowed during tuition times unless it is a major emergency.
(Valuable time with their Educator will be lost by students)*

GRADES R – 7

All items available from KLEREMARK, 19 Hoop Street, Robertson

- *Royal Blue sport shirt & black sport shorts*
- *Navy Blue Soft Shell Jacket and navy tracksuit pants*
- *Royal Blue Cap with school badge (for sport)*
- *Black or white “tekkies”*
- *Black or white short socks*
- *Navy scarf or beanie (for winter)*
- *Navy or royal blue long sleeve t-shirt - to wear underneath the sport shirt (for winter)*
- *Navy puffer jacket (winter – any make, may have a small emblem, e.g. Nike tick)*

****All students must arrive and exit the school wearing their school shoes. Students may remove socks & shoes during breaks on hot summer days. (No bear-feet or flip-flops permitted).**

School bags

- *Navy or black school backpack*

Hair & Nails

- *Clean & short nails - must not show over finger tips (safety for sport & break time activities)*
- *No colour cutex (only clear - no glitter)*
- *Boys Hair - short and neat / Girls Hair - long hair tied back and out of the face, hair accessories must be navy, royal blue or black (same as school uniform).*
- *No unnatural coloring of hair, i.e. blue, green, pink, etc.*

Make-Up & Jewellery

- *No base or foundation, eye-shadow, eye-liner, mascara, lipstick, lip gloss or colour lip ice is permitted.*
- *No jewelry is permitted, except for safe, small earrings for girls' pierced ears.*
- ***NO JEWELRY for any grade for sport practices or matches – SAFETY!***

- *Navy golfer shirt – boys & girls*
- *Navy soft-shell school jacket*
- *Black “tekkies” / shoes*
- *Black or white socks*
- *Navy scarf or beanie (winter)*
- *Navy blue long sleeve t-shirt - to wear underneath the golfer (winter)*
- *Navy puffer jacket (winter – any make, may have a small emblem, e.g. Nike tick)*

Sport Attire ~ all with school badge (available from Kleremark)

Hair & Nails

- Hair beads for braids must be small, clear, black or brown (no colour beads)
- No coloring of hair.

Make-Up & Jewellery

- No base or foundation, eye-shadow, eye-liner, mascara, lipstick, lip gloss or colour lip ice is permitted.
- Earrings for girls only - 1 piercing per ear (small loops or small studs)
- No other piercings permitted (e.g. nose / eyebrows, etc.)
- No ear piercings permitted for boys.
- **NO JEWELRY for any grade for sport practices or matches- SAFETY!**

Before learners leave for school in the morning parents must see to it that they are appropriately dressed, properly washed (including brushing of teeth) and deodorant applied to avoid body odors.

Transport

The school has no transport of its own, therefore we rely on parents' co-operation for transport to any school event which might occur.

We request parents, whenever possible, to be available to transport students to sport events and school outings.

Discipline and Detention

Discipline is seen as a preventative action rather than a form of punishment. It must be seen as what is done for the child and not what is done to him/her.

When detention slips are handed out, parents will be required to sign the notice and return it to school the following day.
